- 1) Southern Ocean: Blue whales could be making a comeback in the **Antarctic.** The largest creatures ever on Earth, Antarctic Blue Whales saw their numbers plummet from 125,000 to a few thousand. Newly released studies found their calls and songs increasing over time, and encouraging sign of the effectiveness of decades of bans on commercial whaling.
- 2) Netherlands: Amsterdam created more space for bicycles- underwater. Two underwater garages adjacent to the city's Central Station house 11,000 spaces for bikes. Bicycles account for 36% of all traffic in Amsterdam.
