Points of Progress
1) **United Kingdom- The University of Cambridge added 438 solar panels to an iconic late medieval chapel.** The new panels on the roof of the King's College building are expected to generate about 123,000 kilowatt hours of energy per year, which combined with panels on nearby buildings, would lower the college's electricity demand by 5.5%
2) **Sweden- Scientists found a new way to identify illegally harvested timber,** potentially making it easier for officials to enforce environmental protections. Because of it focus on high-value wood, illegal logging can endanger tree species and cause ecological and economic harm.
